The Okavango Polers Trust based in Seronga Botswana, is a community based natural resource management project. The goals are: poverty alleviation through the creation of employment, empowerment of the community and ownership of the natural resources of the Okavango Delta. Income and goal pursuit is through safari operations, in dug out canoes, and the running of a large lodge.

- Reduced the organisations debt from P500,000.00 to current standing of P150,000.00

- Reviewed and changed the pricing structure to increase profit margins to ensure sustainability.
- Implemented a HIV-AIDS education program for the board, all the members and staff and worked with the local clinic on HIV education programs for the community.
